

### High Treason in the War of 1812

Hall of Shame: The only known surviving copy of an 1814 poster listing all those convicted of treason during the infamous Ancaster Assize as well as those who were outlawed, but not captured, for serving with U.S. forces and those who forfeited their property as a result of the proceedings. All those who can give information of any persons not included in the above List liable to declared Aliens by the Statute, 54th George III, as having left the Province durin the late War, without Licence; or of any Lands owned by them, or any of the above named individuals, on the 1st of July, 1812, or afterwards, not heretofore forfeited, are hereby requested to communicate the same to the Sheriff of the District wherein they reside, or to the subscriber at York, for the information of the Commissioners for the disposal of Confiscated Estates.
